Your daughter has signed the following agreement outlining the rules of behaviour for our trip to Barcelona. You may wish to discuss this with her over half-term.

We are looking forward to taking you to Barcelona.

We want to make sure that we all have a wonderful time and that everybody is safe.

School rules apply to all members of Heathfield School, whether girls are in or out of school.

The main purpose of these rules is to ensure your safety and for this reason it is very important that you listen carefully and follow all instructions given to you by a member of staff.

We will have a meeting where we can discuss the behaviour, language and dress appropriate when on a school trip so that you understand clearly the standard of behaviour expected of you during the school trip to Barcelona. At this meeting you will be asked to sign this agreement showing that you understand what is expected of you and that you also understand what might happen if you break these rules.

To be absolutely clear:

- You must listen carefully to and follow instructions
- Shorts and very short skirts are not permitted
- You are not permitted to buy or consume cigarettes, drugs or alcohol, or to leave your hotel room at bedtime without permission from a member of staff
- You should realise that any infringement of these rules may result in those involved being returned to school or home as quickly as possible at their parents' expense
